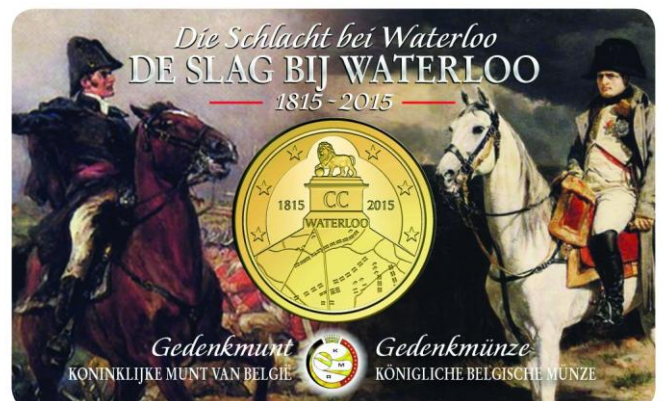
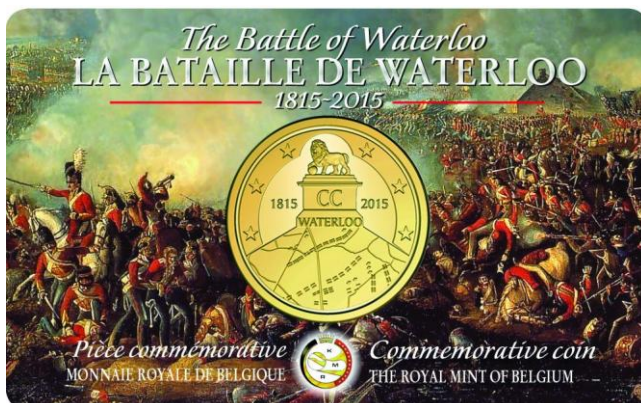
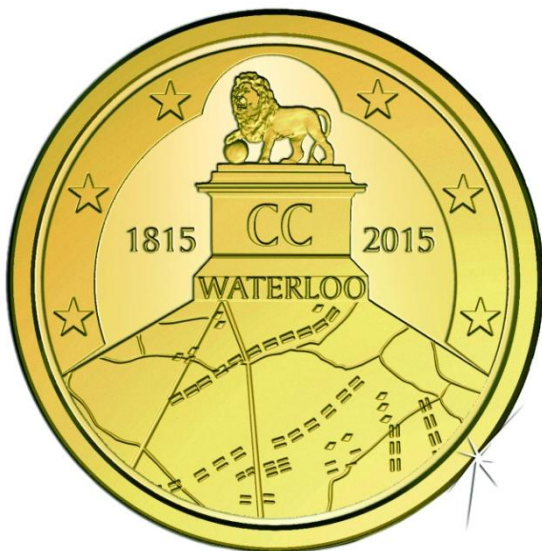
### Presentation Coin Programme Mai 2015

The Royal Mint of Belgium presents its coin programme for Mai 2015. The key issues are the commemorative coins of the bicentenary of the Battle of Waterloo.

#### 2,5 € coin in coin card.

The Royal Mint of Belgium tried to issue a 2 euro coin to commemorate the bicentenary of the Battle of Waterloo, but sadly failed in its attempt. Instead a new denomination coin, a **2,50 € coin** is issued.

The issue limit of this coin is 100.000 of which 70.000 in a coin card and 30.000 in the BU set 2015

Issue limit in coin card: 70.000

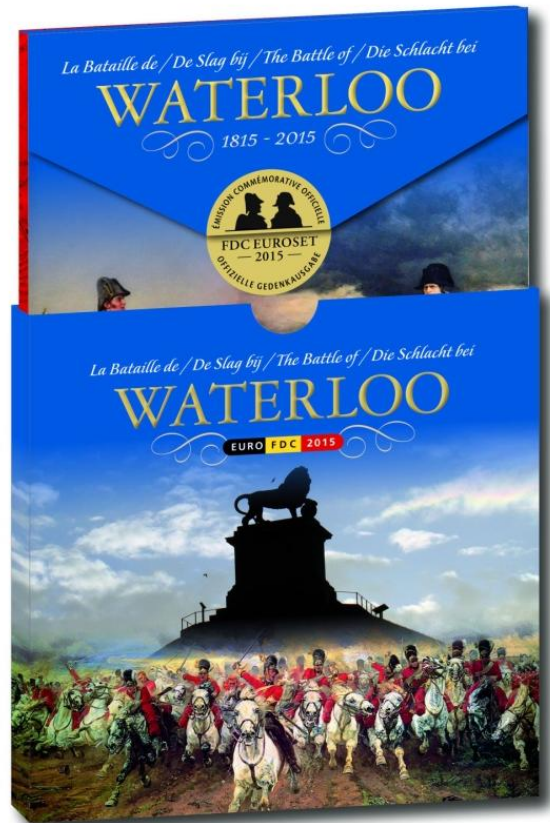

## BU set 2015 Waterloo.

The 8 official Belgian values of 2015 in BU quality with the 2,50 € coin as a 9th coin.

**Belgium will not strike 1 euro nor 2 euro coins for circulation in 2015!**

## 10 euro Coin Waterloo

A 10 euro coin is issued for the bicentenary of Waterloo as well.

diameter: 33 mm

Weight: 18,75 gram

Issue limit: 10.000 coins in total

The coin is presented in a wooden luxury  
as well as in the plastic 12 star box.

## 10 euro and 50 euro "70 years of peace in Europe"

70 years ago ,in 1945, the second war ended. Since then there has been a period of relative peace in Europe. This anniversary is commemorated by a large number of countries in Europe.

## 20 euro the Abduction of Europe

In the Greek mythology Europe was abducted by Zeus who presented himself in the form of a bull, and took her to the island of Crete. The Royal Mint of Belgium issues a 20 euro coin with the symbolisation of this mythological scene.

## The 25 euro coin "The Joyous entry of the emperor Charles V"

500 years ago, in 1515, Charles V made an joyous entry in Belgian cities, like Antwerp, Bruges and Ghent. It is only the second time that we issue a 25 euro gold coin.



Alloy: Au 999°

diameter: 18 mm

Weight: 3,11 gram

Issue limit: 1.500 coins
